IMPORTANT INSTRUCTIONS/ INFORMATION FOR APPLYING ADMISSION TO DIPLOMAS, UNDERGRADUATE MEDICAL AND PARAMEDICAL PROGRAMS

- 1) Candidates are advised to read the prospectus carefully before filling and submitting **ADMISSION APPLICATION FORM** for admission.
- 2) Candidates must retain this Prospectus with them till admissions and read carefully the instructions and comply with all instructions therein strictly.
- 3) This Prospectus is subject to alteration(s) or modification(s) at any time without prior notice. For updates, please refer to University website from time to time.
- 4) Candidates should submit the admission form for Diplomas, Under Graduate **Medical and Paramedical Programs** 2025-26 online along with the prescribed application fee through university admission portal **admissions.sgrduhs.in** on or before the closing date i.e. **30/05/2025**, failing which the candidate will not be considered under any circumstances.
- 5) The admission application form fee of Rs. 2,000/- can be paid online using payment Gateway **through net banking, debit card, credit card and UPI (Google Pay, PhonePe, PayTM)**. Once admission form fee deposited in the university account shall **not be Refunded/Adjusted in any case**.
- 6) Once the application form is submitted online, the students can track the progress of their admission through websites **www.sgrduhs.in** and **admissions.sgrduhs.in**. In case of any discrepancy in the application form, the prospective students are advised to clear the discrepancy within a stipulated time. Failing to do so will lead to rejection of application form.
- 7) Admission Applications received will be rejected if:
 - a) It is not received by the due date & time.
 - b) The requisite fee is not deposited.
 - c) The entries are incomplete.
 - d) Information given in Online Application form is wrong like incorrect category.
- 8) Correct category must be filled carefully in the online application form. No claim shall be allowed if category/categories are not indicated in online application form. In case of any discrepancy or contradiction the University shall be the final authority.
- 9) Candidates will be responsible for any mistakes made by him/her in his/her application form. University shall not be responsible for the same.



- 10) Date, Time and Venue of Entrance Test for B.Sc. undergraduate courses and counselling schedule will be uploaded on University Website/ University admission portal. Therefore all the candidates are requested to periodically check the websites **www.sgrduhs.in** and **admissions.sgrduhs.in**.

Eligibility for Sikh Minority Quota:

- 1) A candidate will be considered Sikh/belonging to Sikh Community if he/she practises the Sikh faith, and maintains Sikh appearance i.e.(is`KI srUp), he/she does not cut or trim hair and has the word “Singh/Kaur” with his/her name, has faith in the Ten Sikh Gurus and Sri Guru Granth Sahib only, and does not owe allegiance to any other sect or religion.
- 2) A male/female Sikh candidate who does not have the word “Singh/Kaur” with his/her name, may get it added legally (that is through an affidavit plus notice in a newspaper regarding change of name) before submission of his/her application by the last date.
- 3) A candidate can also appear in the Entrance Examination who has appeared in the qualifying examination in the annual examination but his/her result is awaited. However, candidature will be considered only if he/she passes and fulfill the eligibility criteria as mentioned above, before the date of first counselling.

SCHEME OF ENTRANCE EXAMINATION (FOR VARIOUS B.SC. PROGRAMS)

The competitive entrance test for BPT, B.ASLP & other B.Sc. comprises objective type questions (MCQ) shall be of 2 hours duration and shall be held at Sri Guru Ram Das University of Health Sciences, Sri Amritsar. The Written Examination will be based on the syllabus of 10+2 (Medical Stream). It will consist of one booklet comprising of 4 parts, containing questions as under:

The competitive entrance test for all Diploma Programs comprising objective type questions (MCQ) shall be of 2 hours duration and shall be held at Sri Guru Ram Das University of Health Sciences, Sri Amritsar. It will consist of one booklet comprising of 2 parts, containing questions as under:

Marking Scheme:

- There will be no negative marking.
- For each correct answer, 1 mark will be awarded.
- There shall be no rechecking/revaluation of response sheets.
- Minimum qualifying marks for admission are 35% (for general/Open category/Sikh minority Quota) and 30% (for SC/BC/Handicap Category).

METHOD OF SELECTION

- a) The selection of the candidates for the admission to the various **degree and Diploma programs** will be made on the basis of the marks obtained by them in the qualifying entrance examination.
- b) The selection of the candidates for the admission to the **various lateral degree courses** will be made on basis of the marks obtained by them in the qualifying examination i.e. Diploma in concerned subject. Admission will be on the basis of the merit list of diploma courses results. The decision of the selection board shall be final.

COUNSELLING PROCEDURE

1. The selection committee is constituted for conducting the counselling and finalizing the admissions by Registrar, Sri Guru Ram Das University of Health Sciences, Sri Amritsar.
2. Counselling of reserved categories will be held prior to general category. The reserved category candidates selected have the right to opt the seat in the general category as per his/her merit. (If it is so the reserve category candidates opting seat in the general category will not be counted towards reserve category.)
3. The exact seats available in various categories for admission to Medical and Paramedical Courses will be displayed on the notice board of the University / website of the University at the time of counseling.
4. The waiting list of all successful candidates will be prepared by the Chairman, Selection Committee and the details of vacant seats shall be displayed on the notice board. It will be operated by the Chairman, Selection committee calling the candidates for Counseling.
5. Number of seats may be increased or decreased by the University and final category wise seats will be calculated and displayed at the time of counseling.
6. The Physical presence of candidates along with his/her parents is essential at the time of counseling.
7. The candidate **must** bring all the following **original documents/ Testimonial** at the time of counselling:



- I. Transaction detail for Rs. 2000/- in favor of “**Registrar, Sri Guru Ram Das University of Health Sciences, Sri Amritsar**” payable at Amritsar.
- II. Matriculation examination certificate indicating the date of birth.
- III. Marks sheet certificate of 10+2 or equivalent examination.
- IV. Admit card of 10+2 of CBSE.
- V. Detail Marks Card 10+1.
- VI. Character certificate from the school / college last attended.
- VII. Migration Certificate from Last Attended Board.
- VIII. Four recent passport size photographs duly attested with name and father’s name written on the back side **along with one photograph of both parents.**
- IX. Gap Year affidavit (if applicable).
- X. Copy of Aadhar Card.
- XI. Punjab Domicile certificate/Bonafide resident of Punjab certificate.
- XII. Sikh Minority Affidavit (if applicable)
- XIII. Certificate in support of claim under reserved category as per the specimen given in Prospectus.
